### Welcome to Year 11

May I remind you that all homework is set via 'Show My Homework' and that you can check your child's homework using the app. If you have not yet logged on, please go to the 'Show My Homework' website and log on using the details which were provided in Year 10. If you no longer have your pin number or have forgotten the password please contact your child's tutor, myself or Mrs Scopes who will be happy to help.

May I also politely remind you of the uniform regulations of Aylesford School particularly regarding acceptable footwear and the required length of skirts. Mr Hall's letter to parents and carers from the summer term is on the school website, as is the Parent and Carer Handbook which contains comprehensive guidelines. For clarity, however, school shoes should be plain black, faux leather or a leather shoe with no insignia or sports emblem on.
