

DEED OF VARIATION

The parties to this Deed are:

(1) The Secretary of State for Education (“the Secretary of State”),

- and –

(2) The Aylesford School and Sixth Form College a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 7848367 (“the Academy”).

together referred to as the “Parties”

INTRODUCTION

A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated 21 December 2011 (“the Funding Agreement”) relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an independent school known as Aylesford School and Sixth Form College

B The Parties now wish to vary and amend the terms of the Funding Agreement and wish to record their agreement as to such variations/amendments to the Funding Agreement by this Deed.

LEGAL AGREEMENT

1. Any word or phrase used in this Deed shall, if that word or phrase is defined in the Funding Agreement, bear the meaning given to it in the Funding Agreement.
2. The Secretary of State and the Academy agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Funding Agreement shall be amended in accordance with Schedule 1 to this Deed.
3. As varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Schedule 1

Amendments to the Funding Agreement

1. Clause 17 of the Funding Agreement shall be deleted and replaced with:

The planned capacity of the Academy is 1399 in the age range 4-18

including a sixth form of 250 places. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive school whose requirements for:

- a) the admission of pupils to the Academy are set out in Annex B to this Agreement; and
- b) the admission to the Academy of and support for pupils with SEN and disabilities (for pupils who have and who do not have statements of SEN) are set out in Annex C to this Agreement;

2. Annex D of the Funding Agreement shall be deleted.
