NHS Test and Trace: COVID-19 testing for staff and students

Dear Parent / Carers

We are working to keep our school as safe as possible. You may have heard that testing for those without coronavirus symptoms is to take place prior to the Spring Term 2022.

Along with the other protective measures we are taking, these tests will help staff and students to remain in school/college safely. Up to one third of people who have coronavirus experience no symptoms. By testing we will help to stop the virus spread and help to keep our school open as safely as possible. The test is voluntary, but I would encourage everyone to take it.

We aim to commence testing all staff and students who want to participate, and who we have written consent on Wednesday 5th January 2022. Students will be tested and will then leave the school site.

I enclose an instructional leaflet and the registration and consent form which MUST be returned to school prior to any testing taking place, if not already completed from previous testing.

If you have NOT previously given consent and wish to give consent please read the [consent form](#) which is within this letter, and if you are happy for your child to be tested, please fill in the registration (one per student) via this link: [LFT Registration and Consent](#)

Those taking the test will be supervised by trained personnel. The 'lateral flow' tests are quick and easy using a swab of your nose. For under 18s, personnel can oversee the swab process.

Results (which take around 15 minutes from testing) will be shared with students participating if it is positive. Where participants are under 16, parents or legal guardians will also be informed.

We know these tests work - in validation studies conducted by Oxford University and Public Health England, they were shown to be as accurate in identifying a case as a PCR test (99.68% specificity). The tests have lower sensitivity but they are better at picking up cases when a person has higher viral load, hence the need to test frequently. Testing will be offered free of charge.

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What if a pupil tests positive?

Participating staff and pupils who test positive will be informed about their results individually. Where participants are under 16, parents or legal guardians will also be notified. Guidance on safe travel and additional precautions will be provided along with test results.

Pupils will need to take a further 'PCR test' (similar to those done in local and regional testing sites) on the same day (or as soon as possible). During this time while they wait for the PCR result (via text / email) they will need to self-isolate.

If the PCR test returns a positive result they will have to self-isolate and follow the guidance from NHS Test and Trace.

What happens if the test is negative?

They will be able to return to school on Thursday 6th January 2022 and resume their activities as normal at the start of term. A pupil will only be told if they test positive on a 'lateral flow' test, so if you do not hear you can assume it was negative. A small number of pupils may need to repeat the test if the first test was invalid or void for some reason.

What if my child develops symptoms?

This testing programme at school is for people with no symptoms. If your child develops symptoms at any time, such as a high temperature, a new continuous cough, or a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste, they must immediately self-isolate, and book a test by calling 119 (England, Wales and Northern Ireland) or 0300 303 2713 (Scotland) or visiting <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>.

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NHS Test and Trace Consent Form for COVID-19 testing

This common consent form has been designed for use by parents and guardians of pupils and under 16s, pupils and students over 16 and staff. Underlined sections should be read as applicable and completed as follows:

- For pupils and students younger than 16 years - this form must be completed by the parent or legal guardian. Please complete one consent form for each child you wish to enroll.
 - Pupils and students over 16 can complete this form themselves, having discussed participation with their parent / guardian if under 18.
 - Staff will complete this form themselves.
1. I have had the opportunity to consider the information provided by the school/college about the testing, ask questions and have had these answered satisfactorily, based on the information presented in the letter dated 7th December 2021 and the Aylesford School – COVID-19 Testing at home of students in Secondary Schools Privacy Statement .
 2. In the case of under 16s, I have discussed the testing with my child and my child is happy to participate. If on the day of testing they do not wish to take part, then they will not be made to do so and consent can be withdrawn at any time ahead of the test.
 3. I consent to having my child having a nose swab for a lateral flow test.
 4. I understand that there may be multiple tests required and this consent covers all tests. If, on the day of testing they do not wish to take part, then I understand they will not be made to do so and that consent can be withdrawn at any time ahead of the test.
 5. I consent that my child's sample(s) will be tested for the presence of COVID-19.
 6. I understand that if my child's result(s) are negative on the lateral flow test, I will not be contacted by the school/college except where they/you are a close contact of a confirmed positive.
 7. If the lateral flow test indicates the presence of COVID-19, I consent to my child having a PCR test by booking one online.
 8. I consent that they will need to self-isolate following a positive lateral flow test result, until the results of the confirmatory PCR have been received.
 9. I agree that if my child's test results are confirmed to be positive from this PCR test, I will report this to the school and I understand that my child will be required to self-isolate following public health advice.
