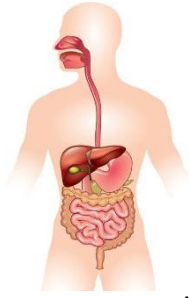


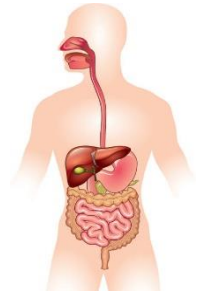
Dragon homework: Summer term
