

Pegasus Class: Creative Homework Tasks

Summer Term- Muck, Mess and Mixtures

The children will have two pieces of homework each week:

- Weekly spellings on Spelling Shed
- A piece of work which will consolidate learning from class on Purple Mash



Also 10 minutes a week spent on Numbots to increase Maths fluency.

Homework will be set on a Wednesday and is to be submitted by Monday morning.

Creative homework can be completed in any way you wish. Previously, we have had some fantastically original pieces such as posters, artwork, photographs of visits, models, constructions and more!

<p>Create a fact-file about Henri Rousseau, the artist that we will be studying in school.</p>	<p>Cook with a grown up and create a storyboard of what you have done. Perhaps you could try one of Roald Dahl's Revolting Recipes?</p>
<p>Think about the Roald Dahl story, <i>George's Marvellous Medicine</i>. Write a list of strange ingredients for a magical potion and decide who you would give it to and what the effects would be.</p>	<p>Optional Science project to complete over half term: Set up a melting Science experiment. Take three glasses and fill them with the same number of ice cubes. Put them in different places and see which melts first. Record your findings using words and pictures (or maybe photographs).</p>
